@EvaDB What are some important things to learn about course waitlist?

Things to know about waitlisting include:

- 1. Being waitlisted for a course is not the same as being registered or enrolled in a course.
- 2. Waitlisting allows students to add themselves to a waitlist for a course that is closed.
- 3. Students on the waitlist will be notified if a seat becomes available on a "first come, first served" basis.
- 4. It is important to monitor your account frequently to ensure you do not miss a waitlist notification.
- 5. If the waitlist for a course is closed, there is a chance that spots may become available later as students remove themselves from the waitlist.
- 6. The chances of enrolling in a class if you are waitlisted or if the class is closed may vary and cannot be guaranteed.
- 7. Towards the end of Phase II registration, waitlists may be removed, and another opportunity to register for desired courses may arise.
- 8. If you are a degree candidate and waitlisted for a course(s) needed to graduate, priority may be given to degree candidates on waitlists.
- 9. Waitlist positions may change due to degree candidates receiving priority for specific specialization courses.
- 10. It is advised to continue monitoring the courses you are interested in and/or the waitlists, and consider alternative courses if necessary.



If you have an Immunization hold, it means that you have not provided proof of immunization or have not completed the necessary waiver form. To resolve this hold and be able to register for classes, you need to send an email to immunizations@health.gatech.edu and request a Waiver Request Form. Once the waiver is submitted, it will be valid for one year from the date it is signed. Distance learners are also required to complete the yearly waiver, even though they do not need to provide proof of immunization.
