License for the BOSS Program

1. The licensee is granted a nonexclusive license for unlimited users to install and use the software system known as BOSS on any computers in one department of a college, university or other non-profit organization. The BOSS software system means all files obtained with the BOSS distribution including executable code, parameter files, test jobs, users manual, and auxiliary programs including *autozmat*. Installation on computers in more than one department of a college, university or other non-profit organization requires a multi-department or site license. Licensor warrants that the software will perform as described in the user's manual.
2. The licensee has no ownership rights in the BOSS software, OPLS force fields or in any copyrights for the BOSS software, OPLS force fields or documentation through this license.
3. The licensee shall not distribute any portion of the BOSS software system or of any derivative works based upon the BOSS software system to third parties without prior written authorization from Cemcomco, which will not be unreasonably withheld. Permission to publish unpublished algorithms and force field parameters from BOSS can also be negotiated.
4. The licensee may demonstrate the use of the BOSS software to third parties on computer systems operated by the licensee as designated in point 1 above.
5. Use of the BOSS program will be appropriately acknowledged in publications, e.g.: Jorgensen, W. L.; Tirado-Rives, J. *J. Comput. Chem.* **2005**, *26*, 1689-1700.
6. The licensee recognizes the developmental nature of the BOSS software system and will hold no person or organization liable for any damages resulting from its use.
7. Licensor warrants that the software will not infringe upon or violate any patent, copyright, trademark, trade secret, or other proprietary right of any third party. Should the software become the subject of a claim of infringement of a third party's proprietary right, licensor shall accept the return of the software and reimburse licensee for charges in the last year.
